



## **Law Enforcement Officers Weekend: Pistol Competition**

*All those who sign up for any of the pistol events must participate in a safety briefing and acknowledgment of the range and instructor rules. Each shooter must sign a range rules and acknowledgment sheet before participating.*

### **Competition #1: Marksmanship Contest**

#### **Format:**

- Squads established depending on number of participants. Competitors will be randomly drawn for order of shooting
- Target will be a standard backer with a total of seven, 8-10" circles with marked scoring rings numbered and laced for each stage of the competition. (See example diagram on Page #3)
- Total rounds = 50 rounds of practice ball ammo of any caliber

#### **Scored Shooting for Marksmanship:**

**Round #1 will have no time limit as follows:**

#### **25 yard line:**

5 rounds standing  
5 rounds kneeling  
5 rounds prone

#### **15 yard line:**

10 rounds standing  
10 rounds kneeling

#### **7 yard line**

15 rounds fired in two phases at two separate bull's-eyes

**Scoring:** Each circle on the target will be numbered with a 10 ring, 9 ring, 8 ring and so on. Best possible score is 500 points. Each stage will be scored by instructors, with all shots marked at each stage to enable proper credit for every shot taken.

- **One winner per squad will advance to final rounds depending on number of shooters.**
- **Single elimination, one winner.**

## **Competition #2: Timed Contest**

### **Format:**

- All stations begin with firearms in holster, in the interview position.

### **25 yards:**

8 rounds standing and 8 rounds kneeling with a tactical reload in 30 seconds

### **15 Yards:**

12 rounds standing, 12 rounds kneeling with a tactical reload in 30 seconds

### **10 Yards:**

15 rounds in 15 seconds with combat reload

### **7 yards:**

5 rounds one handed strong side and 5 rounds non-dominant one hand weak side in 15 seconds

### **5 yards:**

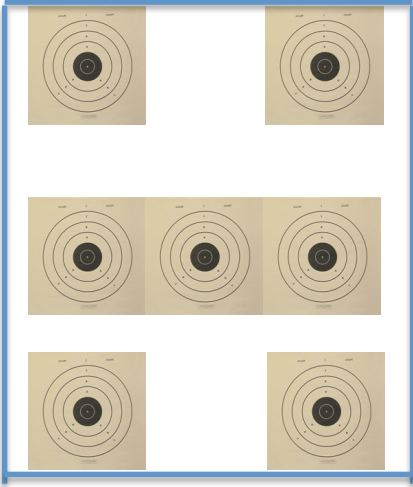
5 rounds to the brain box in 5 seconds

**Scoring:** Any round within the “Q” area counts. In order to score, shots must be completed before the time allotted expires. Rounds not fired within the time allotted will be removed from the weapon or magazines by instructors. Shots from the 5 yard line **MUST** be in the brain box area of the “Q” target to count. All shots before the 5 yard line will be counted and marked by instructors before the 5 yard stage is fired.

- **One winner per squad will advance, single elimination.**
